

Volunteers from the Technisches Hilfswerk (THW) coordinate the acceptance, pre-sorting, palletisation (if not already) and the containerisation of the donations on site. The collection points are open every weekday from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Donations in kind are collected, which are particularly needed in the crisis areas in Poland and Ukraine. According to the experts on site currently, these are but not limited to blankets and clothing to protect against the cold (e.g. scarves, gloves, thick socks, thermal underwear, jackets).

There is also a need for medical products see the list on homepage for full lists such as bandages and first-aid kits. The people in Ukraine and refugees from the country also need durable food (e.g. canned food, pasta, rice). Other possible donations in kind are hygiene and baby items (e.g. diapers) and charged power banks. For the time being, we ask that no other donations in kind such as everyday clothing, children's toys, fresh food or electrical equipment be made.
