SUPPLEMENTAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RRS S.4.1 – SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 1.1.** The flag pole will be located on the west lawn of the clubhouse.
- 1.2.** When Code Flag AP is displayed on shore, "1 minute" is replaced with "30 minutes" in *RRS Race Signals AP*. This changes *RRS RACE SIGNALS*

2. RRS S.5.1 – SCHEDULE OF RACES

2.1. Racing will occur:

	First scheduled Warning Signal	No Warning Signal after
Saturday June 17	1100 hrs	-
Sunday June 18	1000 hrs	1430 hrs

2.2. Number of races

	Maximum number of races per day	Maximum number of races in event
Keelboat fleets	5	8
Dinghy fleets	6	10

2.3. RRS S.5.2 is changed by replacing “five minutes” with “one minute”.

3. RRS S.6 - CLASS FLAGS

3.1. Replace “Class” with “Fleet”. This changes *RRS Appendix S.6.1*.

3.2. Fleet Flags will be as follows.

3.2.1. Alpha Course

J22	Numeral Pennant #2
J80	Numeral Pennant #8
SHARK 24	SHARK Insignia on contrasting background

3.2.2. Bravo Course

Fleet	Flag Description
505	505 Insignia on White background
Albacore	“AL”/Maple leaf on White background
Fireball	Numeral Pennant #1
VIPER 640	VIPER 640 Insignia on a White background

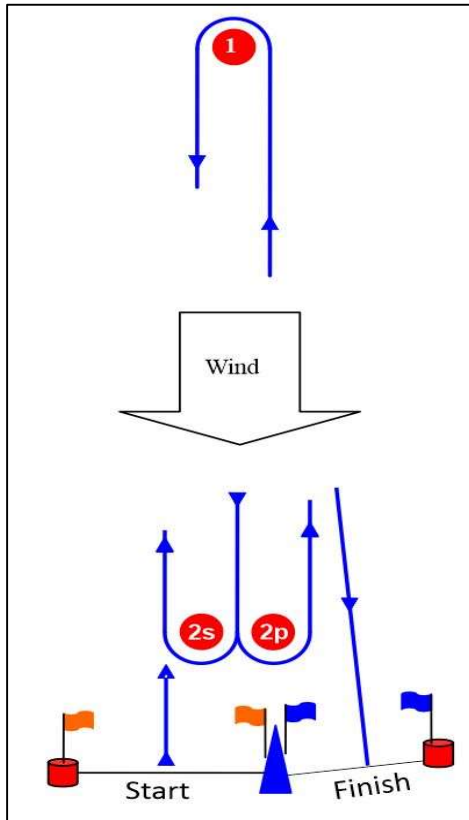

4. RRS S.7 THE COURSES

4.1. Insert the following:

RRS S.7.3 The designated course will be displayed from the stern of the signal boat.

4.2. The following course is added to *RRS Appendix S Course Diagrams*.



Course LP – Windward/Leeward, Leeward Finish to Port	
Signal	Mark Rounding Order
LP2	Start – 1 – 2s/2p – 1 – Finish
LP3	Start – 1 – 2s/2p – 1 – 2s/2p – 1 – Finish

5. RRS S.8 – MARKS

5.1. Mark 1 will be a tetrahedron mark of either Orange, Yellow or Green. The Mark 1 to be used for each fleet will be indicated by displaying the appropriate colour when posting the course on the stern of the Signal Boat.

5.1.1. If an Offset mark is being used (Mark 1a) it will be a smaller red ball mark.

5.2. Marks 2, 2p, 2s and 3 will be Yellow Ball inflatables.

5.2.1. If there is only one mark at the gate, it shall be treated as a single mark taken to Port.

5.3. The *Start* and *Finish* marks will be a float (or boat) with flag poles, and displaying an Orange flag for start, and Blue flag for finish.

6. RRS S.10 – CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

6.1. Insert the following:

RRS S.10.2 To signal the new mark to be used, the committee boat will display Code Flag C along with the colour of the new target mark, while making the appropriate sound signals. This changes *RRS Race Signals, Changing the Next Leg* and *RRS 33*.

7. RRS S.12 – TIME LIMITS

7.1. Time limits will apply to each individual fleet

	Mark 1 Time Limit	Race Time Limit	Finishing window
Keelboat fleets J22; J80; SHARK; Viper 640	20 Minutes	60 Minutes	20 minutes
Dinghy fleets 505; Albacore; Fireball	15 minutes	45 minutes	15 minutes
