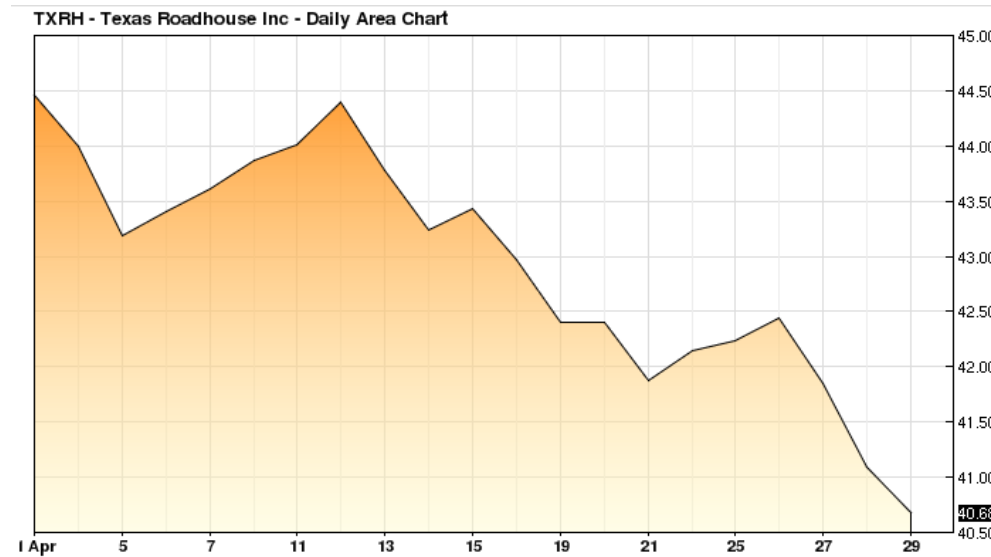
Texas Roadhouse, Inc. [TXRH] (AMC)

Texas Roadhouse, Inc. will be posting its Q1 16 quarterly earnings results. TXRH is expected to post earnings of \$0.54 per share and revenue of \$515 million for the quarter. In the last quarter the company reported \$0.32 earnings per share for the quarter beating the analysts' consensus estimate of \$0.30. TXRH is up 0.7% over the last month and up 18.3% over the last 3 months. The stock price is up 19.2% over the last year.
