GameStop Corp. [GME] (AMC)

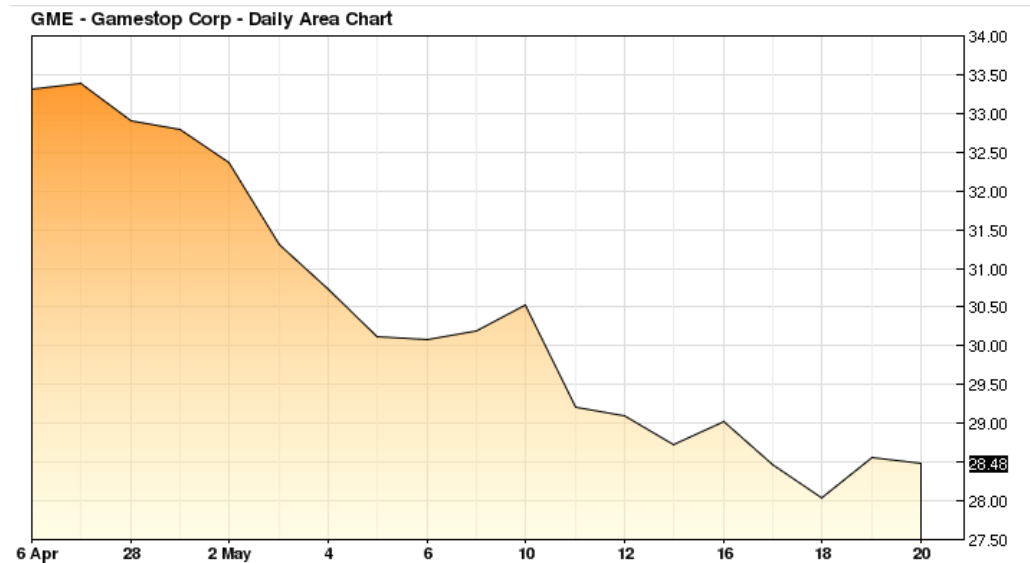
Scheduled for release May 26, 2016(after market close)

GameStop Corp. will be posting its Q116 quarterly earnings results. GME is expected to post earnings of \$0.61 per share and revenue of \$1,947 million for the quarter. In the last quarter the company reported \$2.40 earnings per share for the quarter beating the analysts' consensus estimate of \$0.61. GME is down 8.7% over the last month and up 6.5% over the last 3 months. The stock price is down 26.7% over the last year.

Consensus Estimates: \$0.62 (whisper) \$0.62 (estimate) \$0.60 (wall street)

StockJumpers trajectory analysis reveals a positive market reaction to the release. We are long for the event on news that pushes the stock price up – but cautious about timing as it may not be sustaining.
