



Drawer Pull Installation Guide

• Tools Needed

- Drill
- 3/16" drill bit
- Level
- Painter's tape
- Tape measure
- Screwdriver
- Pencil
- Protective eye wear

• Installation Guide

1. Use your measuring tape to determine where you want to install your pull drawers and mark with painter's tape;
 - One pull drawer install: measure to find center of drawer.
 - Two pull drawer install: measure drawer into quarters (or your preferred placement).
2. Mark on the painter's tape the exact placement of the drawer pull(s). Use a level after marking to make sure your drawer pull(s) will be level.
3. Once you have your markings where you want them, use your drill (with a 3/16" drill bit) to drill a hole;
 - Surface mount pulls: only drill to the depth of the screw.
 - Through mount pulls: drill all the way through the drawer.
4. Test fit the drilled hole with your screws. If hole is correct, go ahead and drill a second hole where you marked earlier.
5. Remove painter's tape.
6. Insert screw into drilled holes;
 - Surface mount pulls: insert screw from front side.
 - Through mount pulls: insert screw from back side.
7. Once both screws are installed, tighten with a screwdriver.
8. Check that pull has been installed securely.
