

## **Shower Rod Installation**

## **Tools Needed:**

- Small Blade Screwdriver
- Phillips Screwdriver
- Level
- Drill with 1/8" Bit
- Pipe Cutter / Hacksaw (Optional)

## Parts Included:

- 2 Straight Rods
- 2 Flanges
- Mounting Hardware



## Installation Instructions

- 1. Measure wall opening.
- 2. Place the two ends of the rod together, if it came as two pieces.
- Measure rod. You can cut both ends to shorten rod. You can increase size by sliding flange out up to 1/2" (1" total). For best results, have rods extend into flange up to the end of the guides inside the flange.
- When desired size is achieved, slide flanges on each end and install rod in opening.
  \*\* Do Not use set screws yet. \*\*
- 5. After rod is secured to walls, use a level to make sure rod is level side to side and front to back. Now install set screws. A 1/8" pilot hole is recommended for optimum strength.
